Data Protection Policy

The Stereoscopic Society is established with the objects set out in its constitution and is a data controller within the UK. The personal information referred to in this Policy may include name, contact details, service records, records of entries to events, and such other information as may be necessary for the effective management of the legitimate interests of the Stereoscopic Society.

The Stereoscopic Society collects and holds personal information about:

1. The Committee, other appointees, and its members.
2. Other individuals necessary for the conduct of the business of the Stereoscopic Society. This includes, but is not limited to, contact details persons responsible for hiring halls and hotels for meetings and Conventions, equipment suppliers, coach contractors, printers, etc
3. Photographers as the creators of images used in the activities of the Stereoscopic Society.

This personal information is held in personal computers owned by Committee Members.

This information may be used in the publication of the Journal of 3D Imaging, membership lists, catalogues, Programmes, Newsletters, Notices, Competition results, awards, Folio Groups circulation lists, or publicity related to the Stereoscopic Society aims or objectives and events.

The Stereoscopic Society may retain historical archives for example but not limited to, records of meetings, handbooks, catalogues, awards and other event results.

Any person wishing to verify the personal information about them, held by the Stereoscopic Society, may apply to the Honorary General Secretary, or in his absence to the Chairman.
